In some parts of the world today, up to 70 percent of the pharmaceuticals are counterfeit. The protections Americans currently have against a flood of counterfeit medicines will vanish if HR 2427 becomes law, because the HHS Secretary will be stripped of authority to certify the safety of such medicines before they cross our border.

HR 2427 offers the illusion of protection: a new holographic-type identification packaging requirement that provides no assurance that the contents themselves are genuine!
