# 5 Steps for Partnering

1. **Create/update** your company and personal profile
2. **Open timeslots** for partnering meetings on your Calendar
3. **Send meeting requests** – use the Search Directory to narrow down best opportunities
4. **Respond to all incoming meeting requests** in the Meetings page
5. **BIO will schedule** your accepted meetings starting late May



# Login and Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

Logging into BIO Partnering™ requires multi-factor authentication (MFA).

MFA code will be sent to your email address. Follow the prompts to enter the code and access the system.

You will be prompted to follow the two-step authentication process each time you log in.

## Guest Access

Invite a guest to help manage your BIO Partnering account.

In the **Preferences** section of your **Delegate profile**, add the email address of your guest.

Once added, they will log in with their email address and receive MFA verification codes to their email, but they will **work as you** in BIO Partnering.

# Partnering Best Practices

## Prepare your profile

**Add as much information as possible** to help other companies find you, so you can get the right requests. Add assets, services, market products when applicable. Select specific TAs and MOAs.

## Start early

**Begin now** to allow others time to respond. Target the most relevant prospects using Advanced Search filters.

## Tailor each meeting request *\*NEW\* AI Messaging*

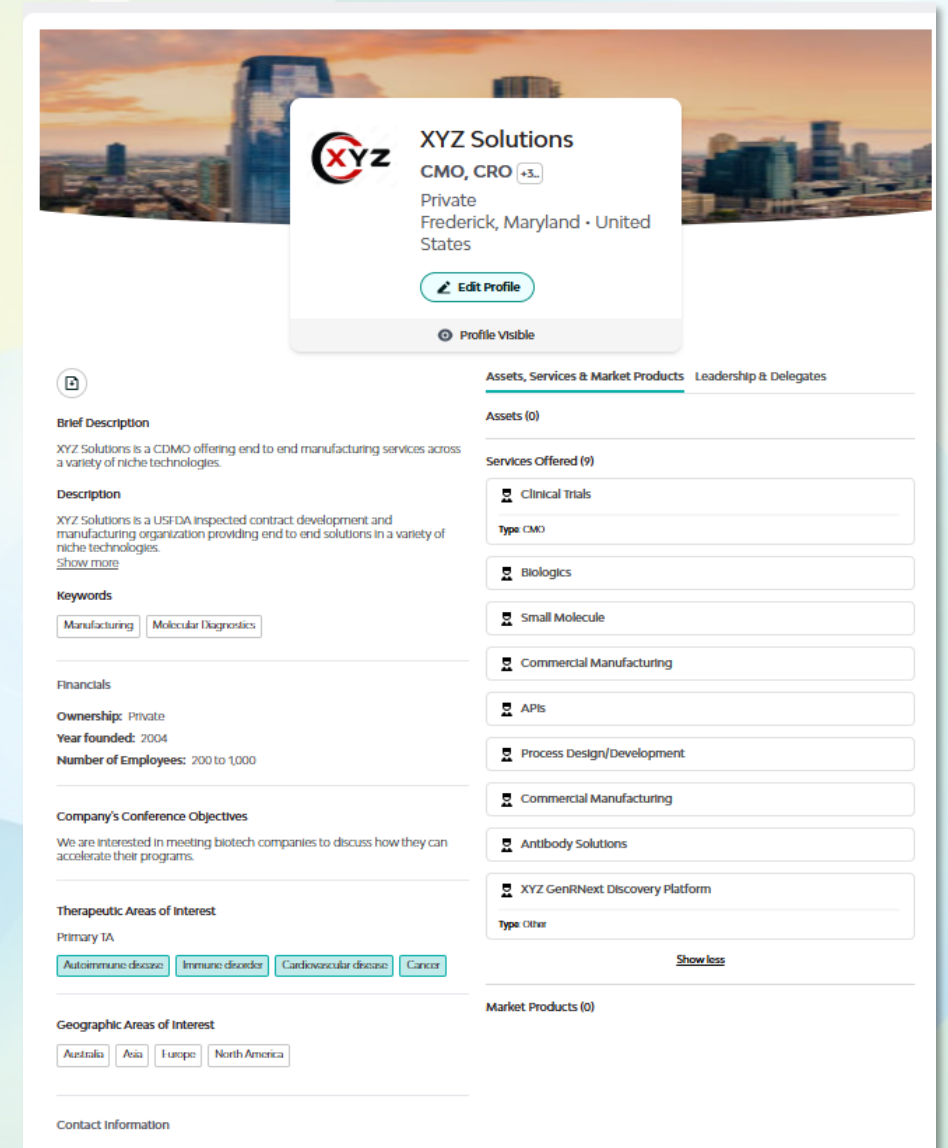
**Be specific** about why you are reaching out to a company based on their profile.

## Follow up

Getting close to the conference but no response? Write a **“reply only” message** to the company.

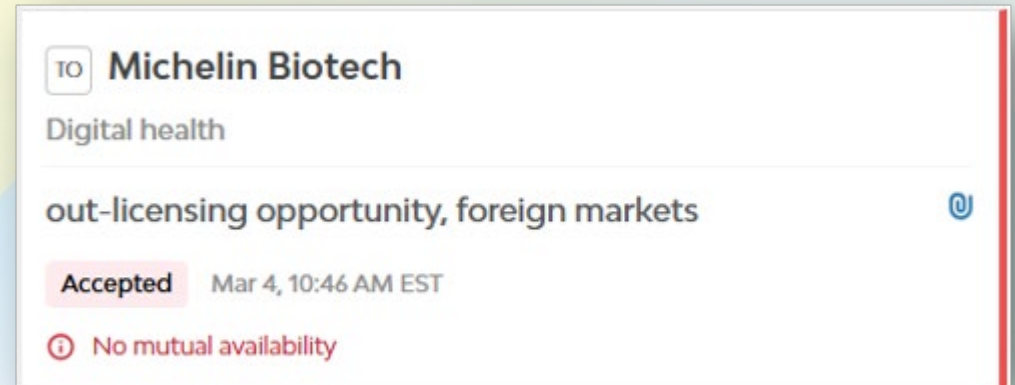
## Max out your requests

**Use all 150 meeting requests** available to your company.



## No mutual availability

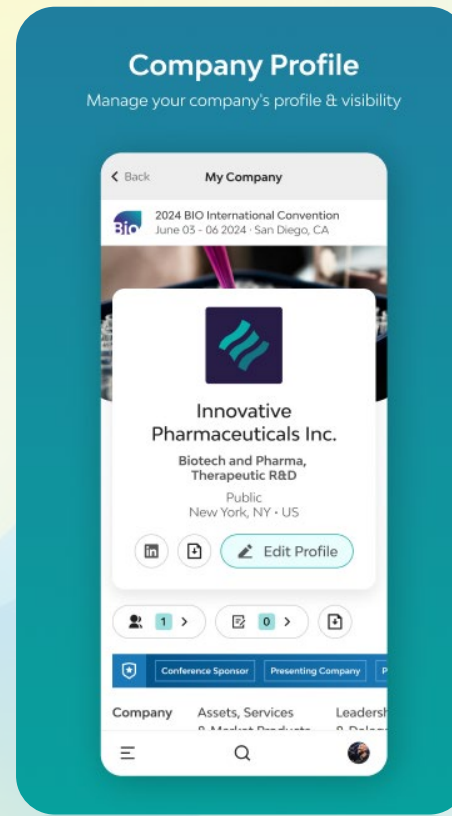
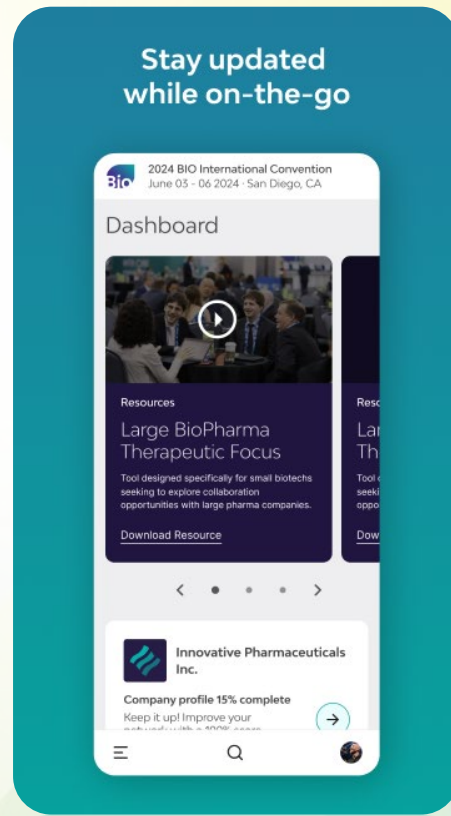
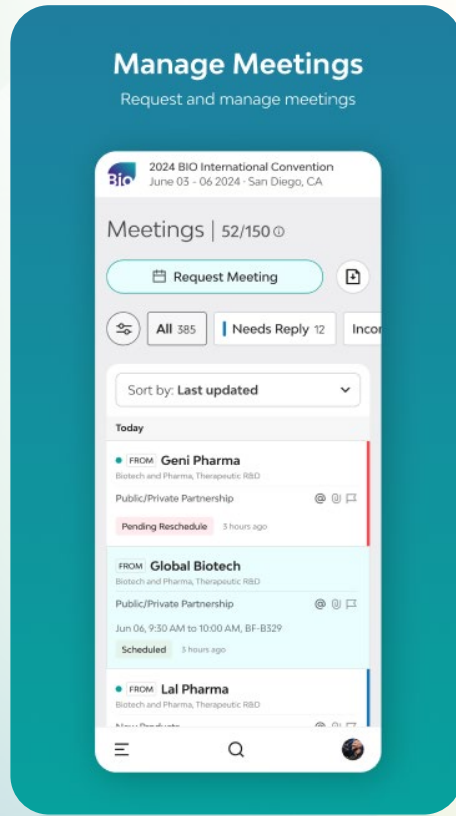
1. Open up more availability on your calendar.
2. Open up availability on your colleagues' calendars if they are also in the meeting.
3. You only need one required participant per meeting, consider making others optional participants where possible.
4. Reply to see if the other company's participants can open more time on their calendars.



→ **This meeting will not be scheduled** until the system can find mutual availability among required participants.
